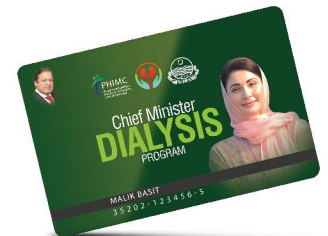

CHIEF MINISTER'S CHILDREN HEART SURGERY PROGRAM (CMCHSP)



Under the Chief Minister's Children Heart Surgery Program (CMCHSP), patients born with Congenital Heart Disease are being treated from **Punjab, Sindh, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Balochistan, Gilgit-Baltistan, Islamabad, and Azad Jammu & Kashmir**—ensuring equitable access to advanced cardiac care across Pakistan.

"This program envisions no patient is left behind due to system gaps or financial limitations."

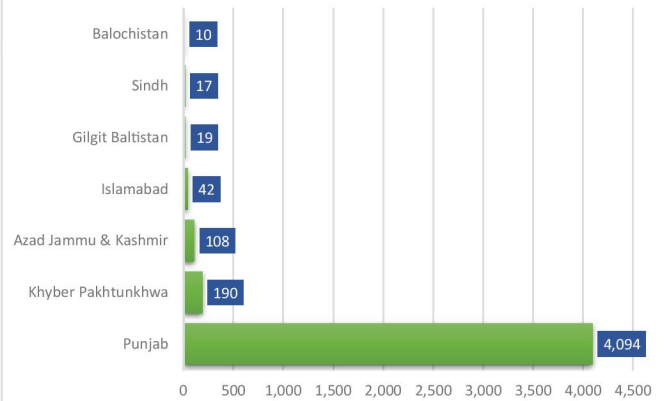
Who Is Eligible?

- Patients of any age, diagnosed with Congenital Heart Disease (CHD)
- Residents from all provinces of Pakistan
- Those registered on waiting lists at public sector hospitals

Since its inception, the Chief Minister's Children Heart Surgery Program (CMCHSP) has played a pivotal role in delivering timely, free-of-cost cardiac care to patients with congenital heart diseases across Punjab.

By December 2025, a total of **9,297** patients had benefitted from this transformative initiative, including **4,480** life-saving procedures conducted in the last six months alone.

CHIEF MINISTER'S SPECIAL INITIATIVE FOR TRANSPLANT PROGRAM (CMSITP)



Under the Chief Minister's Special Initiative for Transplant Program (CMSITP), highly specialized and life-saving transplant and cochlear implant services continue to be provided to patients across Punjab completely free of cost. For the first time in the province's history, some of the most complex and expensive medical treatments—once beyond the reach of ordinary citizens—are being delivered without financial burden.

Key Medical Priorities



Under this program, liver and kidney transplant beneficiaries receive one year of free post-transplant medication—ensuring continuity of care and promoting a smooth and sustained recovery.

Only patients approved by Punjab Human Organ Transplant Authority (PHOTA) are eligible for transplant treatment.

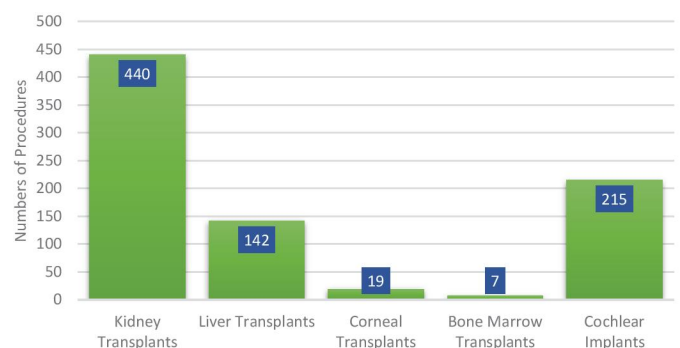


Frequently Asked Questions

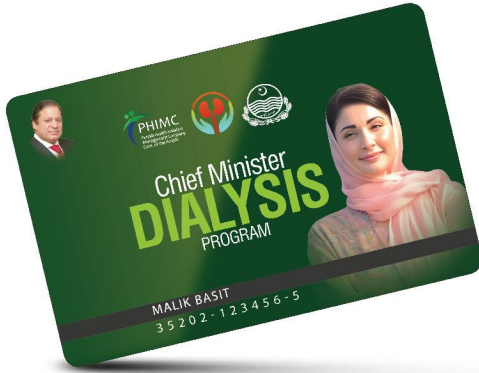
Since the inception of the Chief Minister's Special Initiative for Transplant Program (CMSITP) in February 2025, more than **1,083** procedures have been completed, with over **823** conducted in the last six months alone.

Each intervention highlights Punjab's commitment to equitable, accessible care and reflects the program's rapid expansion through strong coordination between PHIMC, PHOTA, and accredited transplant centers.

CHIEF MINISTER'S SPECIAL INITIATIVE FOR DIALYSIS PROGRAM (CMSIDP)

The program offers a comprehensive benefit package of PKR **1,000,000** per patient per year:

- PKR **850,000** allocated for dialysis sessions.
- PKR **150,000** for allied treatments, (AV Fistula, Double Lumen Catheter, Lab Tests, Medicine, etc.)

Through the Chief Minister's Special Initiative for Dialysis Program (CMSIDP), patients across Punjab are receiving dialysis and allied services completely free of cost.

To date, more than **30,500** patients have been registered under the program, with over **1,161,780** dialysis treatments delivered in Punjab.

Notably, more than **734,234** treatments were provided during the period from July to December 2025 alone, reflecting the program's scale, continuity of care, and the Government of Punjab's sustained commitment to accessible and life-saving renal services for all.

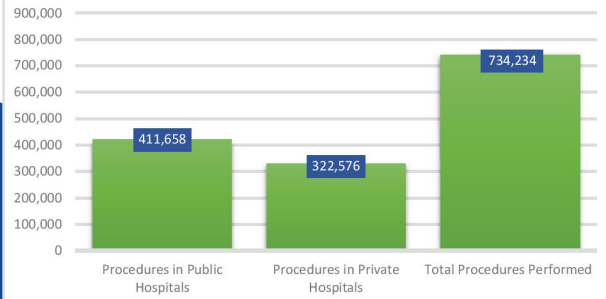

The Sehat Card Program has achieved a major milestone by December 2025, with over **9.6 million** treatments delivered to patients across Punjab. To date, claims amounting to more than **PKR 229 billion** have been processed, reflecting the program's scale and financial protection for beneficiaries.

Under the program, healthcare services worth almost **PKR 10.2 billion** were spent during the last six months, enabling **293,994** patients to receive quality treatment.

This continued support underscores the program's vital role in expanding access to essential healthcare and protecting families across Punjab from the high cost of medical care.

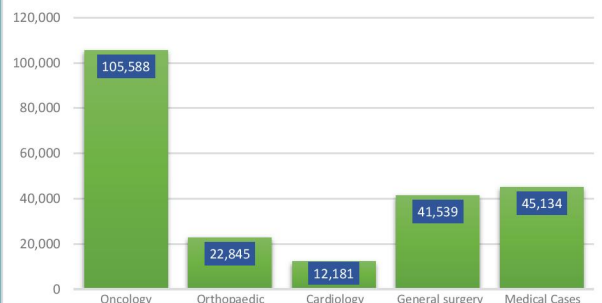

These interactions played a crucial role in reviewing progress, addressing policy and operational matters, and further strengthening the implementation of the following flagship health programs:

The discussions focused on enhancing public-private collaboration, improving service quality, resolving implementation challenges, and ensuring the sustainability and continued effectiveness of these initiatives for the people of Punjab.

MONITORING AND EVALUATION

During the period from 1 July to 31 December 2025, the Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E) team at Punjab Health Initiative Management Company (PHIMC) continued to play a critical role in ensuring quality, accountability, and effective service delivery under the Chief Minister's Special Health Initiatives and the Sehat Sahulat Program (SSP). Field monitoring visits were conducted across Punjab to assess service standards, identify operational gaps, and promptly address public concerns, contributing to improved compliance with program guidelines and enhanced public trust in government healthcare initiatives.

Grievance redressal remained a key priority during this period. A total of 863 complaints were received through the Prime Minister's Performance Delivery Unit (PMDU) and the State Life Insurance Corporation's Management Information System (MIS-SLIC). All reported complaints—33 through PMDU and 830 through MIS-SLIC were successfully resolved, achieving a 100% resolution rate and demonstrating PHIMC's strong commitment to responsive and transparent service delivery.



CHIEF MINISTER'S SPECIAL HEALTH INITIATIVES TO BE LAUNCHED IN 2026



Chief Minister's Cardiac Surgery Program

Cardiovascular diseases are the leading cause of death in Pakistan, accounting for nearly one-third of all fatalities nationwide. Every year, a large number of patients require cardiac surgeries; however, public sector hospitals often face significant patient load and capacity constraints, resulting in long waiting times and delayed treatment. The high cost of private-sector cardiac care further limits access for ordinary citizens.

To address this critical healthcare need, the Government of Punjab has approved the Chief Minister's Cardiac Surgery Program. Under this initiative, all residents of Punjab will be eligible to receive cardiac treatment coverage of up to PKR 1 million per year, ensuring timely and uninterrupted life-saving care without financial hardship.

Public sector hospitals will serve as the primary centers for patient enrollment and treatment. Patients exceeding the treatment capacity of public sector facilities will be referred to empaneled private sector hospitals through the Hospital Management Information System (HMIS), ensuring continuity of care and efficient utilization of available healthcare resources.

MARYAM NAWAZ STROKE INITIATIVE

Maryam Nawaz Stroke Initiative

Stroke is a medical emergency and a leading cause of long-term disability in Pakistan. Ischemic stroke, in particular, requires immediate intervention, including advanced clot-removal procedures, where even minutes can determine survival and recovery. The high cost of emergency stroke care often leads to fatal delays.

The Maryam Nawaz Stroke Initiative has been designed to ensure immediate and fully covered treatment for ischemic stroke, without financial hardship. All residents of Pakistan will be eligible under this program. Patients may be taken to the nearest empaneled hospital, where treatment will commence without delay, reinforcing the principle that in stroke care, time saves lives.



Chief Minister's Special Initiative for Cancer Patient

Cancer is a rapidly growing public health challenge in Pakistan, with more than 150,000 new cases diagnosed annually. The prolonged nature of cancer treatment, combined with the high cost of diagnostics, chemotherapy, radiotherapy, and surgery, makes comprehensive care unaffordable for a large segment of the population.

Through the Chief Minister's Special Initiative for Cancer Patients, the Government of Punjab aims to provide structured financial protection and dignity to individuals undergoing cancer treatment. Under this program, all residents of Punjab will be eligible, and registered patients will be entitled to free cancer treatment of up to PKR 1 million per year at empaneled hospitals, allowing them to focus on recovery rather than financial burden.

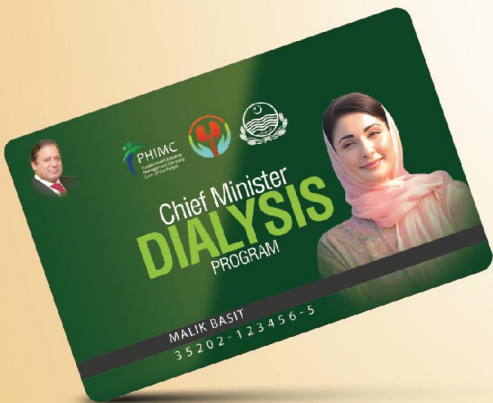
